

Lesson 4

Cain And Abel-True Worship

Bible Portion:

Genesis 4:1-15

Memory Verse:

Hebrews 11:4

By faith Abel offered God a better sacrifice than Cain did. By faith he was commended as a righteous man, when God spoke well of his offerings. And by faith he still speaks, even though he is dead.

Objective:

Children learn that God accepts only true worship according to his will. Hatred and anger will lead to greater sins.

Introduction-The first brothers-Variance of the brothers-Offering-worship-Consequences.

Questions:

1. Let the children draw the picture of an altar with a lamp on it and the fire from heaven coming down on it.
2. Why was Cain cursed? Did he have a way for remission of his sin?
3. What is the peculiarity of the worship according to God's will?
4. Why was Abel's sacrifice accepted and Cain's offering rejected by God.
