Lot's Choice and its consequences

Bible Portion:

Genesis 13:7-18; 19:1-28

Memory Verse:

Genesis 19:17

As soon as they had brought them out, one of them said, "Flee for your lives! Don't look back, and don't stop anywhere in the plain! Flee to the mountains or you will be swept away!"

Objective:

Children realize that wrong choice will lead to destruction and that in every choice there must be a spiritual aim.

Introduction-The conflict of the herdsmen-Solving the problem-Lot's selfish choice-Their separation-God punishes the wicked people of Sodom-The escape of Lot and his family from destruction.

Questions:

1. Draw and colour a picture of Sodom being destroyed by fire.
2. Mark in the map the back of river Jordan and the place where Sodom was (Dead Sea).
3. What was the reason for the separation of Abram and Lot?
4. Which was land Lot selected?
5. What was the reason for the destruction of Sodom by fire?
6. How did Lot escape?
7. What happened to Lot's wife while running away? What was the reason?
8. Who is really wise, the person who seeks the wealth and pleasures of the world? Will you be really wise?
