

## Lesson 14

### The deliverance of Israel

**Bible Portion:**

Exodus Chapters 12, 14 and 15

**Memory Verse:**

Exodus 15:1

Then Moses and the Israelites sang this song to the Lord:

“I will sing to the Lord, for he is highly exalted. The horse and its rider he has hurled into the sea.

**Objective:**

Children learn that Jesus Christ delivers us from the slavery of Sin and Satan.

Introduction-God delivers the people who cried in their afflictions- People delivered under the leadership of Moses-Red Sea divides for Israelites-The enemy Pharaoh and his hosts perish in water-Song of the saved people.
