Bible Portion:

Luke 4:1-13 & Mathew 3:13, 4:11

Memory Verse:

Ephesians 6:11

Put on the full armor of God so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes.

Objective:

Children understand that when Satan approaches us with various kind of temptations, we should overcome them by the Word of God

Introduction-Command the stone to be transformed into bread-To jump from the pinnacle of the temple-To kneel down and worship Satan.

3. What were the temptations that Jesus experienced?

5. Why didn't Jesus jump from the pinnacle of the temple?
6. Why didn't Jesus worship Satan?
7. What do we learn from the lesson? What does God hate most?
