Jesus gives the food to the multitude

Bible Portion:

Mathew 15:32-39, Mark 8:1-10

Memory Verse:

John 6:35

Then Jesus declared, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to me will never go hungry, and he who believes in me will never be thirsty.

Objective:

Children learn that God will provide us with food and all that we need miraculously.

Introduction-Seven loaves of bread and some fishes-Jesus feeds the multitude.

Questions:

1. Make and colour models of seven loaves of bread and a few fishes.
2. Draw a picture of seven loaves of bread and a few fishes in a vessel, write and colour 'Jesus feeds the multitude'.
3. Who all came to hear Jesus preaching and to get healed?
4. For how many days continuously were they with Jesus?
5. Why was Jesus compassionate to them?
6. How many loaves of bread did the disciples bring to Jesus?
7. How many men ate and were satisfied?
8. How many baskets were filled with the remainder of bread pieces?
9. What should we do when we are in need?
