Jesus gives the food to the multitude

Bible Portion:

Mathew 15:32-39, Mark 8:1-10

Memory Verse:

John 6:35

Then Jesus declared, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to me will never go hungry, and he who believes in me will never be thirsty.

Objective:

Children learn that God will provide us with food and all that we need miraculously.

Introduction-Seven loaves of bread and some fishes-Jesus feeds the multitude.

Questions:

- 1. Make and colour models of seven loaves of bread and a few fishes.
- 2. Draw a picture of seven loaves of bread and a few fishes in a vessel, write and colour 'Jesus feeds the multitude'.
- 3. Who all came to hear Jesus preaching and to get healed?
- 4. For how many days continuously were they with Jesus?
- 5. Why was Jesus compassionate to them?
- 6. How many loaves of bread did the disciples bring to Jesus?
- 7. How many men ate and were satisfied?
- 8. How many baskets were filled with the remainder of bread pieces?
- 9. What should we do when we are in need?
