THE PASSOVER

Portion to Read: Math. 26:17-46, Mark 14:12-42, Luke22:7-46, John 13:1-38.

Memory Verse: 1Cor. 11:23, 24:- 23 For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you: that the Lord Jesus on the same night in which He was betrayed took bread; 24 and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me."
