

## LESSON 12

### CALEB (Fearless leader)

Portion: Num. 13: 17- 30; 14:20- 25; Josh. 14: 6- 15.

Memory Verse. Isa. 40: 28, 29. - 28. Have you not known? Have you not heard? The everlasting God, the Lord, the Creator of the ends of the earth, neither faints nor is weary. There is no searching of His understanding. 29. He gives power to the weak, and to those who have no might He increases strength.

Central verse: The people who know their God shall be strong, and carry out great exploits. (Dan. 11:32).

Objective: The people who follow Jesus will be unshakable and their life will reflect the glory of God. They will not alter their life according to the situations. Their character and response will be different from that of common people. They will remain close to God and destroy the strongholds of the enemies and convert it into a place of fellowship. Their descendants will also be blessed.
