JESUS' TRIAL

Reading Portion: Mat. 26:57-68, Mark 14:53-65, Luke 22:66-71, John 18:12-24.

Memory verse: John 18:37:- 37 Pilate therefore said to Him, "Are You a king then?" Jesus answered, "You say rightly that I am a king. For this cause I was born, and for this cause I have come into the world, that I should bear witness to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth hears My voice."

Objective: To understand that the son of God who bore no sin was punished on our behalf.
