RUTH (Cont...)

Portion: Ruth 3 and 4

Memory verse: 2 Cor. 11: 2, 3: - 2. For I am jealous for you with godly jealousy. For I have betrothed you to one husband, that I may present you as a chaste virgin to Christ. 3. But I fear, lest somehow, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, so your minds may be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ.
