

Lesson 21
CHRISTIAN BAPTISM

Bible Portion:

Mat. 28:18-20; John 3:22-23.

Memory Verse:

Mark 16:16. Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.

Objective: To understand that all those who are born again through believing Jesus Christ must obey the commandment of God and be baptized by immersion in water in the name of Father, Son and Holy Spirit

Lesson:
