Bible Portion:

1Cor. 5:9-13; 2Cor. 6:14 – 7:1; James 3.

Memory Verse:

1Peter 1:15-16. But just as he who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do; for it is written: "Be holy, because I am holy".

Objective: Born again believers must observe separation throughout their life.
