DAVID (Cont...)

Portion: 2 Sam. 15:1-18:33, 1 King: 1: 11- 39; 2:1-11; 1 Chro.29:26- 28.

Memory verse: Psalm. 68:1-3:- 1 Let God arise, Let His enemies be scattered; Let those also who hate Him flee before Him. 2 As smoke is driven away, so drive them away; As wax melts before the fire, So let the wicked perish at the presence of God. 3 But let the righteous be glad; Let them rejoice before God; Yes, let them rejoice exceedingly.

Objective: Satan is always working to attract God's people to worldness and sin. Sometimes our own relatives may become his tools. But God is faithful to preserve us through all trials. The end of God's saints will be better than their beginning. David is a shadow of Jesus Christ.
