JESUS – THE GOOD MASTER.

Bible Portion:

John 1: 37-51; Mark 1:1-16-20; Mathew 9:9;10:1-4, Luke 6:12-17.

Memory Verse:

Mark 1:17-18. Come, follow me, Jesus said, and I will make you fishers of men. At once they left their nets and followed him.

Objective: To inspire students to follow Jesus as the true disciple in all circumstances.

Lesson:

Introduction – John and Andrew – Their calling – native place and family background – Calling twelve disciples – Follow Jesus as a disciple.

8. What did Jesus say when Nathanael came to him?
9. What was the occupation of Peter and Andrew? When were they called to follow Jesus? Where?
10. After which event did Jesus start preaching the gospel publicly?
