ISRAEL- TENDERING

Portion to read: Isa. 60: 1-22; Eze. 36:24-37; Mk.13:24-34; Lk. 21: 29-33.

Memory verse: Mathew. 24:32-33. 32 "Now learn this parable from the fig tree: When its branch has already become tender and puts forth leaves, you know that summer is near. 33 "So you also, when you see all these things, know that it is near--at the doors!

Objective: the tendering of Israel, the fig tree, is a sign of Jesus' second coming. To understand this great truth and make ourselves ready for receiving Him.
