

Lesson 3.

THE PRIESTLY GARMENTS

Bible Portion:

Exo. 28 & 39;

Memory Verse:

Hebrew 2:9. But we see Jesus, who was made little lower than the angels now crowned with glory and honor because he suffered death, so that by the grace of God he might taste death for everyone.

Objective:

To understand the glory and beauty of Jesus Christ, our high priest and to learn that the priesthood given to Israel was only a shadow for the high priestly office of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Lesson:

Introduction – Official Garments of High priest – long coat (Tunic) – Blue robe – Ephod – Girdle of Ephod – Linen girdle for the blue robe – Breast plate – Urim – Thummim – Its meaning - Mitre (Turban) – perfect nature of Jesus Christ

Official garments of ordinary priests – Long coat – Girdle – Holy mitre(turban).

3. What do the golden bells and the pomegranates in the hem of the blue robe represent?
4. Give the names of two items kept in the breast plate.
