

**Lesson 5.**  
**SACRIFICES OF ISRAEL**

**Bible Portion:**

Gen. 4:1-15, Lev. 1-7.

**Memory Verse:**

Heb. 10:1. The law is only a shadow of the good things that are coming – not the realities themselves. For this reason, it can never, by the same sacrifices repeated endlessly, year after year, make perfect those who draw near to worship.

**Objective:** To learn that a worshiper can attain perfection not through the Old Testament sacrifices which were mere shadows, but only by the supreme sacrifice of Jesus Christ.

**Lesson:**

Levite sacrifices – sweet savour offering – non-sweet savour offering – differences – Meaning of sacrifices – sacrificial death of Jesus Christ.
