JACOB

Bible portion : Genesis: 25: 21- 34, 27:1-45

Memory Verse : Prov. 21:2

Objective : Cheating, trickery, etc. not to be applied; it will have ill effects.

Teaching Aids : Pictures of:

- a) A hunter with bow and arrow.
- b) The twin sons(Esau and Jacob) of Isaac and Rebekah
- c) Red porridge in a bowl.
- d) Jacob, having covered his hands and neck with goat skin and wearing Esau's dress, standing with cooked savory meat before dim-slighted Isaac.
- e) Jacob running away from home
- f) And, a well- prepared teaching note.

Introduction : Do you know children who tell lies to their parent and others to get things done? Such as what? (For example, food items, presents, money etc). How did you come to know about those things which they got using trickery? One day lie will come to light. Isn't it? Those who used cheating, how much sadness and shame they will feel when the truth is revealed. We will study today the consequences of getting blessings by a son from his father by saying lies.
